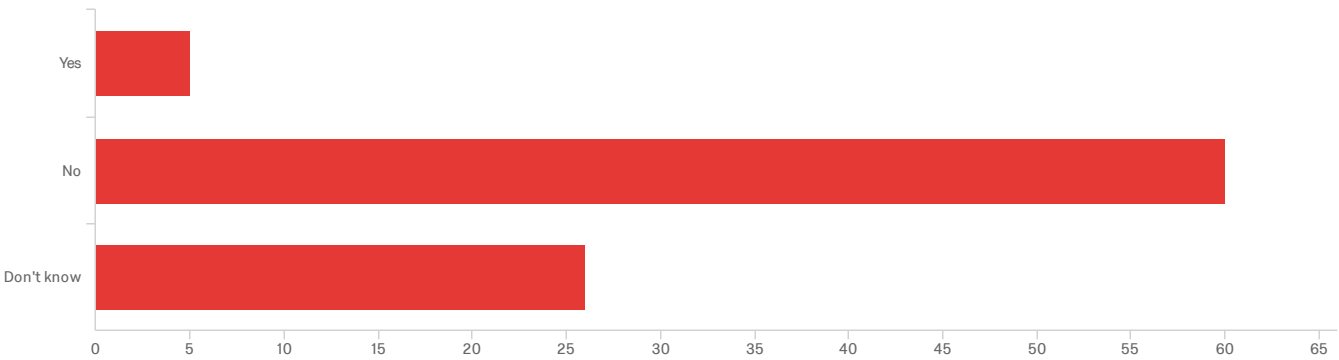
### 9.4 - Was the other person an undergraduate student at [Field-INSTITUTION]?

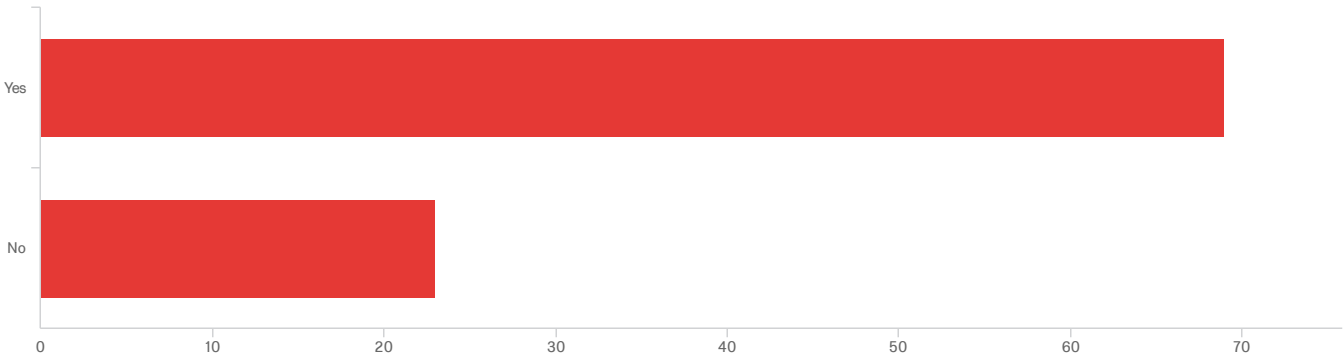
9.5 - Was the other person a graduate or professional student at [Field-INSTITUTION]?

### 9.6 - Did this happen on campus?

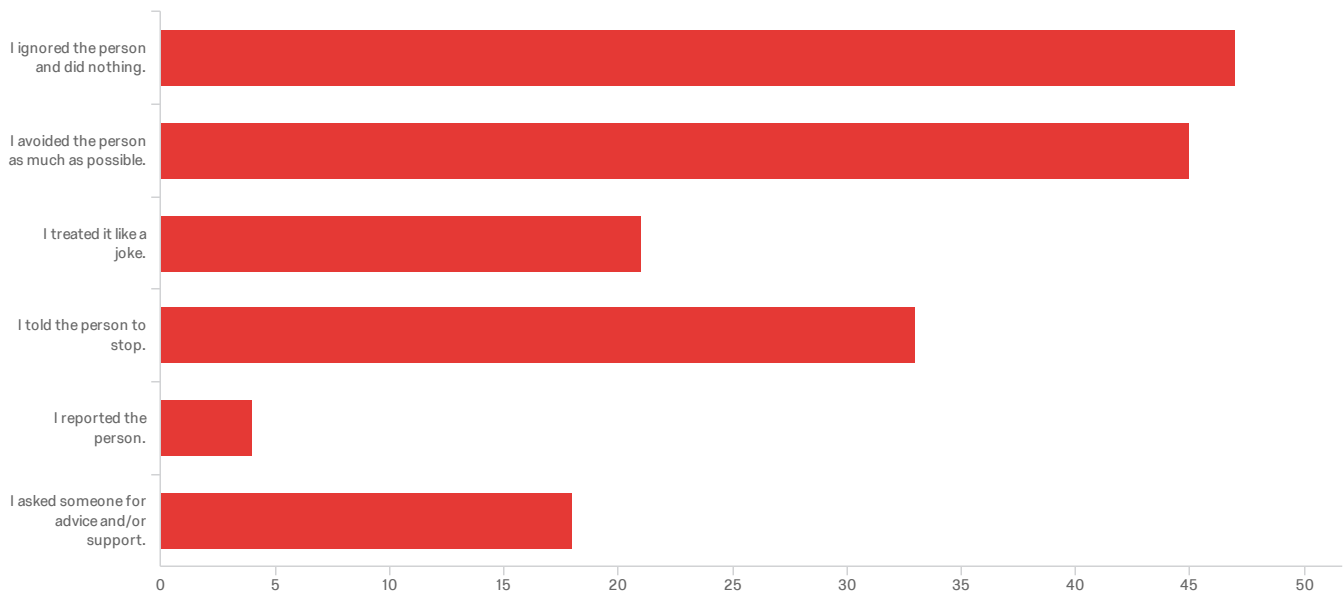
