



The Dobbs Ferry Campus houses our Clinical Health and Simulation Labs, design and animation studios, music and recording studios and our 5,000 square foot fitness center.




Residential Life on the Dobbs Ferry Campus

A PERSONAL MENTOR ON DAY ONE

From the moment students are accepted into Mercy College, they are assigned a personal mentor who advises and inspires them to reach their full potential.

Their PACT mentor is their point person who helps them navigate the twists and turns of their college experience. International undergraduate students may be eligible for academic merit, athletic scholarships and/or transfer scholarships.

IMMIGRATION ADVISEMENT

International Student Services advises on how students can become an F-1 student, I-20 issuance and maintaining status.

CAREER READINESS AND ASSISTANCE

Mercy College authorizes CPT for eligible students (internships for academic credit), and provides assistance with OPT applications to USCIS, one-year full-time work authorization after student completes their program of study plus an additional 24 months OPT extension for STEM eligible programs. The College has dedicated career advisors to support students in their job and internship search process along with presentations on career development/job search specifically for international students.


