Graduates of the program who successfully pass the Praxis exam for speech language pathologists are eligible to begin their Clinical Fellowship (CF) in accordance with requirements of the American Speech-Language Hearing Association. Once they complete their CF, they are then eligible to apply for a STATE license as a speech language pathologist. A speech-language pathologist employed in a school as an educator must, in addition to holding a speech-language pathologist license from OPR, hold an endorsement from the Agency of Education (AOE).</i>
