<p>Barbara Keckler **Online Teacher of the Year**</p>	<p>Education</p>	<p>Before I sat down to write this nomination, I struggled to put to words just how impactful this professor has been in my academic career. Dr. Keckler has served as a teacher, advocate, and friend to me in such profound ways that it is difficult to convey how completely they have inspired me. For these reasons, I am nominating Dr. Barbara Keckler for the Online Teacher of the Year Award. After deciding to submit a nomination for Dr. Keckler, I frantically attempted to note down all of the numerous ways in which she has helped me and so many other students strive to fulfill our academic and personal potentials. It seemed a daunting task to create a cohesive description of the varying ways in which Dr. Keckler has proved an exemplary teacher – her support takes so many forms. So, I decided to categorize her acts of encouragement, assistance, and inspiration into the characteristics that the committee is searching for. I will present my nomination much like an elementary school “hamburger essay” with clear examples of Dr. Keckler’s possession and surpassing of each of the sought-after traits. Dr. Keckler is a standout in encouraging learning in all capacities. I transferred into the Mercy program after my second year of teaching. After having spent many years in an unfulfilling academic undergraduate program where, much to my dismay, I was, in several cases, treated much more as a number than I expected after having heard SUNY New Paltz’s claims of creating unique and personal learning environments for all of its undergraduates; I was not looking forward to going back for my master’s degree. Education 617 was my first lecture in my second year of my master’s. I left the lecture with a new sense of purpose and a changed attitude; my professors truly do care. Throughout the course, Dr. Keckler has provided encouragement in the form of impromptu meetings, personal emails, checking in on our progress and research interests, generous and long meetings at unprecedentedly flexible hours, and a through a genuine interest in our academic and personal lives. Dr. Keckler has been, and continues to be, the most encouraging teacher I have ever had. In my first year of undergrad, I became accustomed to a certain format for the delivery of information. As a student, you sit in a lecture and read from the same textbook each week. If you are lucky, your class will have a seminar or lab where you get more human interaction. Again, after my first class with Dr. Keckler, my mind and view of higher education was expanded tenfold. Not only are all of the readings in Dr. Keckler’s courses free for Mercy students, but they are also of a variety of formats and are sourced from a variety of subjects.</p>

Perhaps the most underrated quality of a professor is their ability to provide constructive feedback on assignments. I have received countless assignments with a number grade and nothing else. Dr. Keckler is the polar opposite of these professors. Not only does she provide critical feedback and indicate exactly where marks were lost, she also provides positive comments throughout students’ works encouraging them to further pursue their interests. This has been a unique experience for me. Dr. Keckler is engaged with all of their students’ work, and their genuine interest encourages us all to do better and create our best academic work. Many professors lead by example; many professors include components of their own research in their teaching. These professors inspire their students in a way that others cannot. Dr. Keckler, however, does more than include slides of her research papers and publications; she uses her research to engage students in participatory ways. Her research is designed to inspire, and her teaching serves to forward this goal. The final tenet of teaching excellence as described by the committee is the demonstration of exemplary concern for students. This is something I can speak to both personally and on behalf of all of Mercy’s students. First, on all of her syllabuses, Dr. Keckler has a section that describes how students’ health, and personal lives are infinitely just as important as the academic requirements of the course. It provides resources for mental and physical health issues, addresses for support centers, and telephone numbers for trusted organizations. Every student – at least every student who reads the syllabus – knows that Dr. Keckler cares for them so deeply. Of course, words on a syllabus are different than actions. But Dr. Keckler has proved that they are more than just words. She is an exemplary example of a compassionate and caring teacher. This month I have been struggling severely with a personal matter. I emailed my professors to provide documentation; and Dr. Keckler was the first to respond. Dr. Keckler offered extensions on all of my assignments but, more importantly, she also expressed her deepest sympathies in a genuine caring way. Dr. Keckler cares for her students so much that I believe she has an unlimited capacity for compassion. It should also be noted that Dr. Keckler has excelled at adapting her curriculum to an online format, offering synchronous and asynchronous activities and making herself available through Zoom and email, on the phone, and whatever else you may need.
