


Register for Classes

After logging into Mercy Connect, you will select Student Hub




> Select Register for Classes either under Student Academics and Registration or Under Registration Tools.







It will bring you to the below page where you will select "Register for Classes."




> If you have hold or it's not time for you to register, you will receive a pop-up in red after selecting the term.



If you have created a plan in the "Plan Ahead" feature, click the Plans tab at the top to bring it up.




- If you have a plan, you can individually pick and choose what classes on the plan to register for or add them in bulk by clicking "Add All."
- If you do not have a plan or want to add courses in addition to what was already planned, you can search via the "Find Classes" tab or by selecting enter CRNs.






- Once you type in the subject you will be able to see the course offerings.
 - To add them to your schedule you will select add.
 - Sections will be added below in a pending status.
 - When your schedule is complete press the submit button to register.
 - Registration will be processed for courses without errors and those will be highlighted in green as registered.



Errors

- If there are errors, you will see them simultaneously displayed in the upper right-hand corner, and they will be highlighted in light red on the summary and schedule.
- In the action drop down, you can remove the courses that received an error.
- To drop a course, select "Web Drop" from Action
- If an error was given because the section is full, you can add yourself to the waitlist via the drop down as well.
- A waitlisted course will be highlighted in green with a Waitlisted status



If a class is waitlisted, you can see your spot on the waitlist by going to the Schedule and Options tab and then by clicking Schedule Details. You will need to click the arrow beside the waitlisted course to expand the information to see your option position.
